From I-81 S, take exit 188A onto Route 60 into Buena Vista. Turn right (south) onto Route 501 (near Hardee's). Travel 1.5 miles following signs to Glen Maury Park. Turn right onto 10th street. Park is half a mile on your right.

From Lynchburg take Route 130 (becomes Route 501 at Glasgow) to Buena Vista. Turn left onto 10th street. Park is half a mile on your right.

Awards Ceremony

RULES

1. Bands must have banjo, guitar and fiddle or mandolin, are limited to 7 members max. No substitutions or additions of band members for first two songs. All band members must be registered contestants.
2. Band manager/designee must attend **BANDMANAGERS MEETING** at **5:30** on **Friday** to review rules & draw for position. If you miss the drawing, your time will be determined by the MC and the other band representatives. Bands that fail to appear when scheduled will be disqualified for the competition.
3. Bands must play two songs. The first is a warm-up/not judged. The second is judged. Other than mic checks, talking (even introduction of band members) is cause for disqualification. If time allows, we may invite you to play a third non-judged song to entertain the crowd.
4. No medley of tunes allowed.
5. Individuals may compete in one band, one instrumental category and in folk song and flatfoot.
6. Individual instrumentalists may be accompanied by one instrumentalist (no vocals). The accompanying instrument can be the same as the instrument being judged; however, the accompanist must be back-up only. Folk singers may sing a Capella, accompany themselves on an instrument; be accompanied by one instrumentalist or accompany themselves on an instrument and be accompanied by one instrumentalist.
7. Children 16 or younger can compete in adult or children's competition. A child may compete as an adult in one competition and as a child in another.
8. Only string acoustic instruments; no electric instruments
9. Taps are not permitted in the dance contest or in the audience.
10. In folk song competition, only authentic folk songs less than 3 minutes allowed.
11. By performing, all contestants agree that the sponsor may record and reproduce performances free of claim by contestants.
