AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TAX RATES FOR THE CITY OF BUENA VISTA, VIRGINIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026

ORDINANCE TEXT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BUENA VISTA, VIRGINIA, that in accordance with Section 26-1 of the Code of the City of Buena Vista, there is hereby levied upon taxable real estate an effective tax rate of Ninety-Eight Cents (\$0.98) per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed valuation for the Fiscal Year 2025-2026, said levy to be based upon the value of such property as of July 1, 2025.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, there is hereby levied upon personal property a tax rate of Five Dollars and Eight-Five Cents (\$5.85) per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed valuation for the Calendar Year 2025, said levy to be based upon the value of such property as of January 1, 2025.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, there is hereby levied upon all public service corporation real estate the sum of Ninety-Eight Cents (\$0.98) per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed valuation for the Fiscal year 2025-2026, said levy to be based upon the value of such property as of July 1, 2025.

BE IT STILL FURTHER ORDAINED, that all other tax rates not expressly defined above shall remain the same until further action by Council.
